## NOTICE OF RACE

---

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.  
Refer - <http://www.yachtingnz.org.nz/racing/safety-regulations>
- 1.3 The Tauranga Cup Rules and Conditions will apply.  
Refer - Tauranga Yacht and Power Boat Club <http://www.yacht.org.nz>.
- 1.4 Under rule 86, *Changes to The Racing Rules* the following racing rules will be changed as follows:
  - Rules 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state that boats still racing but failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be given a finishing position based on the last mark they rounded. Their score will be greater than any boat who rounded further marks or who finished,
  - Rule 40 will be changed to require personal floatation devices to be worn at all times while afloat,
  - Rule 60.1(a) will be changed to state that a competitor cannot protest another boat or competitor for breaches of some specific parts of the Sailing Instructions,
  - Rules A4 and A5 will be changed to state that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.

The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.

- 1.5 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2, or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing. The arbitration process and penalties applied will be in accordance with Yachting New Zealand Regulation 4.5.5, *Arbitration*.

## **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the P Class that comply with the Class Rules and have a current P Class National Certificate in the name of the current owner.

- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached Entry Form and either;

- i. sending it together with the required fee, to

Reference the payment with "P Class" and your sail number,

by 1700 hours on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2016.

- 2.3 Late entries may be accepted up until 9am on Saturday 22 October, 2016, at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

- 2.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

- 2.5 Each competitor shall be under the age of 17 years on 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2016.

- 2.6 The following documents may be requested

- i. proof of yacht club membership,  
ii. P Class National Certificate,  
iii. copy of competitor's birth certificate.

### 3 CLASSIFICATION

There are no classification requirements in accordance with RRS 79.

### 4 FEES

4.1 The required entry fee is \$75.00

### 5 SCHEDULE

5.1 *Registration:*

Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2016

From 0830-0930 hours at the Lake Taupo Yacht Club.

5.2 *Measurement and Inspection will not be necessary. All boats must comply with the class rules and safety.*

5.3 *Briefing:*

Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2016

At 0930 hours at the Taupo Yacht Club.

5.4 *Dates of racing:*

The event shall consist of a series of up to 6 races – (refer schedule below).

Day	Date	Time of First Warning Signal	Number of Races
Day 1	Sat 22 <sup>nd</sup> October	1100	3
Day 2	Sun 23 <sup>rd</sup> October	1000	3
Day 3	Mon 24 <sup>th</sup> October	1000	2

5.5 Races may be sailed back-to-back.

5.6 On Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> October 2016 no warning signal will be made 1400 hours.

5.7 Prize giving will be held at around 1600 hours on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2016

### 6 MEASUREMENTS

- 6.1
1. Each boat shall be certified to its class rules. Any boat can be asked for measurement and inspection.
  2. Competitors shall use one hull, one set of foils, one mast, one boom and

one sail for the entire championships, all of which shall have been measured and marked at the official measuring.

3. In addition, spot measurement and safety checks may be conducted at any time throughout the regatta.

6.2 Beach trolleys shall be prominently marked with the boat's sail number.

## **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2016, Taupo Yacht Club.

## **8 VENUE**

8.1 Lake Taupo Yacht club, Taupo

## **9 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward and/or Triangle Windward/Leeward.

## **10 PENALTY SYSTEM**

Appendix P will apply.

## **11 SCORING**

11.1 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **12 SUPPORT BOATS**

12.1 All support boats must register with the Organising Authority at registration and nominate the boat(s) they support.

12.2 Team leaders, coaches, and other support personnel shall comply with NOR 14.

### **13 LAUNCHING AND STORAGE**

- 13.1 All competing boats shall be kept on the lawn in front of the Lake Taupo Yacht Club, unless instructed otherwise by the Organising Authority.
- 13.2 All competing boats shall be launched from the beach in front of the Lake Taupo Yacht Club, unless instructed otherwise by the Organising Authority.
- 13.3 Support boats should be launched at the Public boat ramp near the Harbour Masters Wharf.

A ramp pass is required and may be purchased through the Lake Taupo Yacht Club.

### **14 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

### **15 PRIZES**

- 15.1 Prizes will be awarded as follows: Trophy's will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place plus 1<sup>st</sup> girl
- 15.2 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority or the NZ P Class Association.

### **16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### **17 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
